## All Africa Senior Championships 2020

We have the pleasure to invite your Association to participate in the All Africa Senior Championships 2020 which will be held in Cairo, Egypt from Sunday 9 to Sunday 16 February 2020. The Championships will be divided into a Team Championships (Thomas & Uber Cups format) and an Individual Championships.

The winners of the men and women teams will represent Africa in the final stage of the Thomas and Uber Cups (World Men and Women Team Championships) 2020 in Aarhus, Denmark from 16 to 24 May 2020.

TEAM COMPOSITION FOR TEAM EVENT COMPETITION	Member Associations can either enter a Men's Team, a Women's Team or both.  Each Team must be composed of MINIMUM four (4) players. If your team has less than four players, you will be NOT be allowed to play in the Team Event competition – but you will be allowed to play in the Individual Event as per your entries made. BCA will give a maximum of 6 medals per winning team including the gold, silver and bronze medalists.  Each tie will be composed of five matches; three singles and two level doubles. Teams winning three or more matches in any tie will be the winner. A player is not allowed to play more than 2 matches (one single and one double) per tie.		
VENUE	Cairo International Stadium, Hall No. 4 Cairo, Egypt.  Practice sessions can be arranged on arrival. Request for practice will have to be sent to the organizers by 5 February 2020.		
VISA	Application for visa must be made to the Egyptian Embassy in your country or a neighboring country. Support letter will be provided upon request from your association. The Hotel is 5 minutes walking to the Hall.  Triple rooms are limited, priority will be given to early bookings.  Check in/out at the hotel is at 12h00. The accommodation and meals charges must be paid immediately upon arrival.

BCA PARTICIPATION GRANT	Each participating team will be eligible to receive a financial assistance which will include travel or/and a hotel grant. The exact amount will be communicated to you after the entry deadline.		
BWF ID	Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. In case you wish to enter players, who do not have a BWF ID-number, you can now generate new BWF IDs for your players via Tournament Software.		
	If you need assistance to generate BWF IDs, kindly contact us before the entry deadline of the tournament.		
TEAM MANAGERS' MEETING AND DRAW	The Team Managers Meeting will be held on Sunday 9 February 2020 @ 18h30 in the meeting room of the official Hotel. The DRAW of the Team Event Competition will be held in the Team Managers Meeting.		
	The seeding for the Team Event will be based on the BWF World Team Ranking and according to the BWF General Competition Regulation. The Referee's decision will be final.		
INSURANCE	Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property. The organisers will not be responsible for any medical costs.		



DOPING CONTROL	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, could be conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.  Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). BADMINTON INTEGRITY	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and antimatch manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.  To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.  Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
