The BCA Council proposes to amend the Constitution as per annexed document (Annex 4)

This is a BWF led initiative and involves all the 5 Continental Confederations (Asia, Europe, Pan-America, Oceania and Africa). It was also an opportunity for Council, with the BWF assistance, to thoroughly review the BCA Constitution to bring its wordings into closer alignment for some key areas: governance, membership, judicial processes and others.
