Following the BWF report and the BCA Investigative Committee (2019) report on this matter, Council is now proposing to discontinue the case based on legal opinion received.

This proposal is in line with the recommendations of the BWF and the BCA Investigative Committee (2019) as adopted by the AGM in 2019. Both bodies recommended that the BCA should seek legal advice, against FNB (the bank) in South Africa, and to discontinue pursuing the matter in case the legal advice was not favourable.

In 2020, after referring the matter to a legal expert in South Africa, the latter recommended that the case be discontinued and was in the opinion that the BCA will not legally succeed in holding FNB (the bank) liable for the loss.

Consequently, Council agreed to stop pursuing the matter in line with the 2019AGM's decision and in order to avoid any (further) fruitless spending on this matter.
