Member Associations can enter a Mixed Team composed of at least 2 men and 2 women; that is, minimum four players and a maximum of 12 players (6 men and 6 women). If your team has less than 2 men or 2 women, you will be NOT be allowed to partake in the Team Event Competition.

Team Composition for Team Event

Depending on the number of players entered in your team, BCA will give a maximum of 12 medals per winning team (6 male and 6 female players) including gold, silver and bronze medallists.

Each tie will be composed of five matches: one men's singles, one women's singles, one men's doubles, one women's doubles and one mixed doubles. Teams winning three or more matches in any tie will be declared as the winner. A player is not allowed to play more than 2 matches per tie. In the group stages, all five matches will be played.

The order of play for each match will be decided by the Referee and her decision will be final.

All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System.

The tournament will be played on knock-out system and in full accordance with the General Competition Regulations of the BWF and the instructions of Badminton Confederation Africa.

Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered. All prizes (including prize money) will be distributed during the official prize giving ceremony after the finals.

Players shall not plan their departure before the prize giving ceremony; the organisers will not award medals or prize money before the finals.

Conditions

According to the BWF General Competition Regulations, there is no world ranking points for an international tournament with less than 8 entries in (MS, WS, MD, WD, XD).

In such a case, the tournament maybe cancelled, and the organisers will not take any responsibility for any arrangements that may have been already made.

Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9

GCR 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

Visitors are permitted to enter the country, by land or air (Entebbe International airport) with a negative PCR COVID-19 test taken no more than 72 hours before boarding aircraft in-bound to Uganda.

Covid-19 Restrictions

(Important)

The Government of Uganda requires that all departing passengers present a negative PCR COVID-19 test taken not more than 72 hours before departure. This requirement is mandatory for all departing passengers out of Uganda even if the destination country does not require it. For a full list of accredited laboratories and approved sample collection points, please visit the Uganda Ministry of Health's website.

Travelers are expected to cover all costs associated with their COVID-19 test prior to departure, from their country of origin. In Uganda, the organisers will cover the costs of all tests (except the mandatory PCR test at the airport). In case of any positive case, it is strongly recommended that all participants take a medical and travel insurance to cover any unexpected medical expenses.





Unvaccinated incoming passengers will have to undergo a mandatory PCR test at Entebbe Airport at a cost of \$50. Passengers will have to wait for the test results (4 hours approx.) before they are authorized to leave the airport. Fully vaccinated (2 doses, whenever applicable) passengers are exempted from the PCR test and will be authorized to enter the country after immigration.

Travelers who test positive will be taken to a quarantine facility or to a Ministry of Health facility for treatment or given the option to be repatriated (for foreigners), at their own cost.

A nationwide curfew is enforced from 9pm to 6am. Note that arriving and departing airline passengers will be exempt curfew restrictions when their flights take place during quarantine hours.
