Doping Control	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Clothing and Advertising	Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and antimatch manipulation, and this code applies to all participants in this tournament.





	To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course of result of a game or a match.			
	Every person has an obligation to report to BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of matches.

	Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered. All prizes (including prize money) will be distributed during the official prize giving ceremony after the finals.			
	Players shall not plan their departure before the prize giving ceremony; the organizers will not award medals or prize money before the finals.			
Conditions	According to the BWF General Competition Regulations, there is no world ranking points for an international tournament with less than 8 entries in (MS, WS, MD, WD, XD).			
	In such a case, the tournament maybe cancelled, and the organizers will not take any responsibility for any arrangements that may have been already made.			
	Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9			
	GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."			
Covid-19 Restrictions	Visitors are permitted to enter the country, by land or air (Murtala Muhammed - Lagos International airport) with a negative PCR COVID-19 test taken no more than 72 hours before boarding aircraft in-bound to Nigeria.			
(Important)	The Government of Nigeria requires that all departing passengers present a negative PCR COVID-19 test taken not more than 72 hours before departure. This requirement is mandatory for all departing passengers out of Nigeria			





even if the destination country does not require it. The list of accredited laboratories and approved sample collection points are:

Travelers are expected to cover all costs associated with their COVID-19 test prior to departure, from their country of origin and before leaving Nigeria. In case of any positive case, it is strongly recommended that all participants take a medical and travel insurance to cover any unexpected medical expenses.

In-bound travelers will be subject to temperature and health screening upon arrival.

Any arriving passengers who exhibit signs or symptoms of an infectious disease will be transported to an isolation center for a COVID-19 test where they must remain, at their own cost, until the results of the test are received. Travelers who test positive will be taken to a Ministry of Health facility for treatment or given the option to be repatriated (for foreigners), at their own cost.

Quarantine is not required for arriving foreign nationals who have a negative PCR COVID-19 test result done by an accredited laboratory in the country of origin, unless the person exhibits signs or symptoms of an infectious disease.

Compliance to NCDC COVID-19 Protocol, Confirmation of Strict social distancing, mask wearing and other sanitary measures will be observed for the duration of the tournament, for more information about COVID 19 Safety Protocol, click here: BFN-COVID-19-SOP
