<p>Events</p>	<p>1. Mixed Team Championships - 11 to 14 Dec 2. Individual Championships - 15 to 17 Dec All five events (MS, WS, MD, WD & XD) shall be played for the Individuals' Championships and shall count for the BWF World Junior Ranking.</p>
<p>Referee</p>	<p>Referees Team for the Individual and Team Events will be announced soon.</p>
<p>Venue</p>	<p>National Badminton Centre (9 Courts) Practice sessions can be arranged upon request and will be subject to court availability.</p>
<p>Shuttlecock</p>	<p>TBA (BWF Approved Shuttles).</p>
<p>Team Managers Meetings and Draw</p>	<p>Sunday 11th December 2022 @ 09:00hrs in the meeting room of the official Hotel or the venue. The DRAW of the Team Event Competition will be held during the Team Managers Meeting and first matches will start in the evening on the same day. The schedule may be subjected to change, please contact the organisers for more details.</p>
<p>Regulations (Team Event)</p>	<p>Member Associations can enter a Mixed Team composed of at least 2 men and 2 women; that is, minimum four players. If your team has less than 2 men and 2 women, you will NOT be allowed to partake in the Team Event Competitions and receive the BCA Grant. However, if any team has less than 2 men and 2 women, the Referee may allow them to play in the group stage only, on a participatory basis; that is, their matches won't count for the group standing results and they won't qualify for the knock-out round or receive medals.</p>

**Regulations
(Team Event cont.)**

The format of the Team Event Competitions will be a group phase followed by a knock-out round. BWF General Competition Regulations will apply to the Championships.

Each tie will be composed of five matches; one men's singles, one women's singles, one men's doubles, one women's doubles and one mixed doubles. Teams winning three or more matches in any tie will be declared as the winner. A player is not allowed to play **more than 2 matches per tie**. In the group stage, all five matches will be played.

Depending on the number of players entered in your team, BCA will give a **maximum of 12 medals** per winning team including gold, silver and bronze medallists.

The order of play for each match will be decided by the Referee and his/her decision will be final.

Age Limit

Only players born in **2004 and after (18 years old or less)**, will be eligible to participate in the tournament.

Team Managers will be requested to submit passports of their players to the Referee before the start of the Championships.

The Referee may, at his/her discretion, order a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scan for any player (male or female) entered in the Championships.

Seeding

The seeding of the Team Event and Individual Event will be based on the BWF World Junior Rankings.

All Entries must be submitted using the BWF Online Entry System no later than **Tuesday 15th November 2022** at 23h59 BWF HQ (Kuala Lumpur) time (GMT+8). Member Association must log on to:

<p>Visa</p>	<p>Generally, no visa is required to enter Mauritius. However, to ensure a smooth arrival with the immigration procedures at the airport, please make sure to send the passports of your team members to badminton@intnet.mu by 25 November, 2022.</p>
<p>Airport</p>	<p>Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International Airport Airport Code: <i>MRU</i></p>
<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>1. <u>Gold Crest – Quatre Bornes</u> Price (Full board)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Single Room: USD 100 / Person / Night ▪ Double Room: USD 75 / Person / Night <p>2. <u>Gold Beach – Flic en Flac (Beach Side Hotel)</u> Price (Full board)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Single Room: USD 110 / Person / Night ▪ Double Room: USD 80 / Person / Night <p>Accommodation and meal charges should be paid to the MBA either by bank transfer or on arrival in Mauritius. Check-in at the hotel is as from 14h00 and check-out is at 11h00.</p> <p>The hotels have been certified COVID-19 compliant.</p>
<p>Transportation</p>	<p>Transport will be provided from Airport to any of the official hotels only.</p> <p>Local transportation to and from the venue will be provided free of charge to Participants and Officials for the official hotels only. Gold Crest is 40 minutes' drive from the airport and 10 minutes' drive to the Badminton hall. Gold Beach is 1 hour's drive from the airport and 30 minutes' drive to the Badminton hall.</p> <p>General COVID-19 protocols will be respected for Airport transfers and daily shuttles to and from the venue.</p>
<p>Temperature</p>	<p>In December, the temperature varies around 27°C during the day and at night it's around 20°C.</p>
<p>Medical Services</p>	<p>The organisers will provide medical personnel at all times in the hall for the duration of the tournament.</p>
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property, including Covid-19 related costs. The BCA and the organisers will not be responsible for any medical cost.</p>

<p>BWF ID</p>	<p>Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number. In case you wish to enter players, who don't have a BWF ID - number, you can now generate new BWF IDs for your players via Tournament Software.</p> <p>If you need help to generate new BWF IDs, please contact BWF or BCA (for African Countries) well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can be assigned BWF ID numbers before the closing date of the tournament.</p>
<p>Doping Control</p>	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).</p> <p>For more information about Anti-Doping, please visit the BWF Website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-doping-overview/</p>
<p>Clothing and Advertising</p>	<p>Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.</p>
<p>Badminton Integrity</p>	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants in this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course of result of a game or a match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of matches.</p> <p>For more information, please visit the website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/</p>

<p>Conditions</p>	<p>The tournament will be played in full accordance with the General Competition Regulations of the BWF and the instructions of Badminton Confederation Africa.</p> <p>Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered. All prizes will be distributed during the official prize giving ceremony after the finals.</p> <p>Players shall not plan their departure before the prize giving ceremony; the organisers will not award medals or prizes before the finals.</p>
<p>Conditions (cont.)</p>	<p>According to the BWF General Competition Regulations, there is no world ranking points for an international tournament with less than 8 entries in (MS, WS, MD, WD, XD).</p> <p>In such a case, the tournament maybe cancelled, and the organisers will not take any responsibility for any arrangements that may have been already made.</p> <p>Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9: “In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF’s regulations and Disciplinary processes.”</p>
<p>Covid-19 Restrictions</p>	<p>There are no longer any COVID 19 entry restrictions for travel to Mauritius. Passengers are no longer required to have a COVID 19 vaccination certificate or a COVID 19 test result to enter the country. Quarantine restrictions have also been lifted.</p> <p>All participants entering the country will have to complete and submit the Travel Digital Form at https://safemauritius.govmu.org/</p> <p>At the competition venue, players and their entourage are encouraged to respect sanitary and hygiene measures including social distancing, wearing of masks and others.</p>
