Support letter will be provided upon request from your association.</p> <p><u>Only 14 countries are eligible to apply for online Visa:</u></p> <p>Cameroon, China, DR Congo, Egypt, Ethiopia, Kenya, India, Iran, Mexico, Nigeria, Philippines, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia and Uganda.</p> <p>These countries can apply here: https://www.southafricavisa.com/</p>

<p>Transportation</p>	<p>Transportation to and from the venue will be provided free of charge to Participants for the official hotel only. Savoy Lodge is 15 minutes' drive from the airport and the Badminton venue is less than 10 minutes' drive from the hotel.</p> <p>Transport from airport to the hotel cannot be confirmed yet but Uber rides are available and the cost will be around ZAR200 (≈ USD 12)</p> <p><i>COVID-19 protocols will be respected for Airport transfers and daily shuttles to and from the venue.</i></p>
<p>Temperature</p>	<p>In December, the temperature varies around 27°C during the day and at night it's around 17°C.</p>
<p>Medical Services</p>	<p>The organisers will provide medical personnel at all times in the hall for the duration of the tournament.</p>
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property, including Covid-19 related costs. The organisers will not be responsible for any medical cost.</p>
<p>BWF ID</p>	<p>Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number. In case you wish to enter players, who don't have a BWF ID - number, you can now generate new BWF IDs for your players via Tournament Software.</p> <p>If you need help to generate new BWF IDs, please contact BWF or BCA (for African Countries) well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can be assigned BWF ID numbers before the closing date of the tournament.</p>
<p>Doping Control</p>	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).</p> <p>For more information about Anti-Doping, please visit the BWF Website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-doping-overview/</p>

<p>Clothing and Advertising</p>	<p>Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.</p>
<p>Badminton Integrity</p>	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants in this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course of result of a game or a match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of matches.</p> <p>For more information, please visit the website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/</p>
<p>Conditions</p>	<p>The tournament will be played on knock-out system and in full accordance with the General Competition Regulations of the BWF and the instructions of Badminton Confederation Africa.</p> <p>Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered. All prizes (including prize money) will be distributed during the official prize giving ceremony after the finals.</p> <p>Players shall not plan their departure before the prize giving ceremony; the organisers will not award medals or prize money before the finals.</p> <p>According to the BWF General Competition Regulations, there is no world ranking points for an international tournament with less than 8 entries in (MS, WS, MD, WD, XD).</p> <p>In such a case, the tournament maybe cancelled, and the organisers will not take any responsibility for any arrangements that may have been already made.</p> <p><u>Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9</u></p> <p>GCR 7.9: “In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF’s regulations and Disciplinary processes.”</p>

<p>Covid-19 Restrictions (Important)</p>	<p>All participants should have a Covid-19 vaccination certificate approved by your Ministry of Health should be produced at the port of entry.</p> <p>Partially or un vaccinated persons will have to present a negative 72hr PCR test result and have completed the Traveller Health Questionnaire (THQ) to be allowed in South Africa.</p> <p>Upon arrival in the port of entry, you will be screened for any Covid-19 symptoms. If positive, you will need to self-quarantine.</p> <p>All participants and officials entering the competition venue will have to either present a Covid-19 vaccination certificate or a negative 72hr PCR test result. Although some protocols are now optional, all participants must use their own discretion except when playing their matches.</p>
