	Reservations have to be made with the Organisers. Check in/out at the hotel is at 12h00. The accommodation should be paid directly to the hotel immediately upon arrival.
	The hotels have been certified COVID-19 compliant.
Transportation	Transportation to and from the venue will be provided free of charge to Participants and Officials for the official hotels only. Both Holiday Express and Africana Hotel are approximately 45 minutes' drive from the Airport. The venue is 3.9km from Holiday Express and 2.3Km from Africana Hotel.  COVID-19 protocols will be respected for Airport transfers and daily shuttles to and from the venue.
Temperature	In February, the temperature varies around 24°C during the day and at night it's around 16°C.
Medical Services	The organisers will provide medical personnel at all times in the hall for the duration of the tournament.
Insurance	Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property including Covid-19 related costs. The organisers will not be responsible for an medical cost.
BWF ID	Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number. In case you wish to enter players, who don't have a BWF ID - number, you can now generate new BWF IDs for your players via Tournament Software.
	If you need help to generate new BWF IDs, please contact BWF or BCA (for African Countries) well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can be assigned BWF ID numbers before the closing date of the tournament.





Doping Control	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.  Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). Clothing and Advertising	Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWI General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and antimatch manipulation, and this code applies to all participants in this tournament.  To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course of result of a game or a match.  Every person has an obligation to report to BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of matches.  For more information, please visit the website:

	Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9
	GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is
	reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."
	All participants should have a Covid-19 vaccination certificate approved by your Ministry of Health should be produced at the port of entry.
Covid-19 Restrictions (Important)	Partially or un vaccinated persons will have to present a negative 72hr PCR test result.
	Upon arrival in the port of entry, you will be screened for any Covid-19 symptoms. If positive, you will need to self-quarantine.
	All participants and officials entering the competition venue will have to either present a Covid-19 vaccination certificate or a negative 72hr PCR test result. Although some protocols are now optional, all participants must use their own discretion except when playing their matches.
