	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
Doping Control	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulatio of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, an this code applies to all participants at this tournament.
	To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are no allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game of match.
	Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyon to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).
