Regulations (Team Event)	Member Associations can enter a Mixed Team composed of at least 2 boys and 2 girls; that is a minimum of four players. If a team has less than required, you will NOT be allowed to partake in the Team Event Competitions and receive the BCA Grant.  However, if any team has less than required, the Referee may allow them to play in the group stage only, on a participatory basis; that is, their matches won't count for the group standing results and they won't qualify for the knockout round or receive medals.

The format of the Team Event Competitions will be a group phase followed by a knock-out round. BWF General Competitions Regulations will apply to the Championships.

### Regulations (Team Event cont.)

Each tie will be composed of five matches: one boys' singles, one girls' singles, one boys' doubles, one girls' doubles and one mixed doubles. Teams winning three or more matches in any tie will be declared as the winner. A player is NOT allowed to play more than 2 matches per tie. In the group stage, all five matches will be played.

Depending on the number of players entered in your team, BCA will give a maximum of 12 medals per winning team including gold, silver and bronze medallists.

The order of play for each tie will be decided by the Referee and his/her decision will be final.

#### Age Limit

Only players born in 2009 and after (14 years old or less) will be eligible to participate in the tournament.

Team Managers will be requested to submit passports of their players to the Referee before the start of the Championships. In case of no passports, please bring a verifiable identification document (including photo and biodata). NO Student Card will be accepted without a birth certificate.

The Referee may, at his/her discretion, order a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scan for any player (male or female) entered in the Championships.





#### **Seeding**

The seeding of the Team Event and Individual Event will be based on the last results of the last edition in Ouidah, Benin and other preceding editions. For the Individual Championships, the seeding will be based on the results of the Team Event Competition or as may be decided by the Referee. In any case, the Referee's decision will be final.

Training Camp	BCA, in close collaboration with the Zimbabwe Badminton Association, will organise a training camp for the Under 15 players prior to the start of the Championships (see schedule above). The camp will include both theory and practical sessions and will be led by BCA experts.  Note: The BCA will offer some support for accommodation and/or travelling to all participating teams. Further information will be provided to you by BCA in due course.

Transportation	Transport will be provided from Airport to any of the official hotels.  Complementary transportation will be provided between the official hotels and venues to Participants and Officials only. Monomotapa is 20 minutes' drive (about 13km) from the airport and 15 minutes' drive (about 9km) to the Badminton hall. Holiday Inn is about 20 minutes' drive (about 15km) from the airport and 15 minutes' drive (about 10km) to the Badminton hall.
Temperature	In December, the temperature varies around 27°C during the day and at night it's around 17°C.
Medical Services	The organisers will provide medical personnel at all times in the hall for the duration of the tournament.
Insurance	Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property. BCA and the organisers will not be responsible for any medical cost, including any COVID-19 related expenses.
Doping Control	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.  Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). Clothing and Advertising	Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Accreditation	Access to the tournament venue, transport, hotel and other services shall be restricted to accredited players, officials and VIP personnel only.  The accreditation shall be delivered by the organisers to official delegation members as per entry forms submitted.





	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.
Badminton Integrity	To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.
	Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).
