



Withdrawal and No-Shows

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5). Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organiser are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

Accommodation	Golden Peacock (4 stars) Price (Full board – Breakfast, lunch and dinner) Single Room: USD 120 / Person / Night Double Room: USD 85 / Person / Night				
	Reservations have to be made with the Organisers. Check in/out at the hotel is at 12h00. Accommodation charges must be paid by bank transfer. The Zambia Badminton Association will issue an invoice upon request.				
Transportation	Transportation to and from the venue will be provided free of charge to participants and Officials for the official hotel only. Golden Peacock is about 5km from the venue (less than 15m drive) and about 23km from the airport (about 35m drive).				
Temperature	In November, the temperature varies between 31°C during the day and around 18°C at night.				
Medical Services	The organisers will provide medical personnel at all times in the hall for the duration of the tournament.				
Insurance	Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property. BCA and the organisers will not be responsible for any medical cost.				
Accreditation	Access to the Tournament venue and other services will be provided throug personalised and photographic accreditation.				
Clothing and Advertising	Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.				



BWF ID	Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number. In case you wish to enter players, who don't have a BWF ID - number, you can now generate new BWF IDs for your players via Tournament Software. If you need help to generate new BWF IDs, please contact BWF or BCA (for African Countries) well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can be assigned BWF ID numbers before the closing date of the tournament.
Doping Control	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and in necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game of match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone.

	prize giving ceremony after the finals. Players shall not plan their departure before the prize giving ceremony; the organisers will not award medals or prize money until <u>ALL</u> finals are over.

In such a case, the tournament maybe cancelled, and the organisers will not take any responsibility for any arrangements that may have been already made.
