**Withdrawal and
No-Shows**

Deadline for withdrawals of players without penalty is on **Monday 25th November 2024.**

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Members can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5). Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organiser are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

If a Member needs to withdraw any entries once players have arrived in the host city, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager in person to the Tournament Referee, or Deputy Referee(s), and must also be confirmed in writing to:

<p>Accommodation</p>	<p><u>Neighbourgood Newlands Hotel</u> (3 stars)</p> <p>Price (Half board – Bed & Breakfast)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Single Room: ZAR 1665 / Person / Night (approx. USD 95) ▪ Double Room: ZAR 1865 / Pair / Night (approx. USD 105) <p><i>* The hotel is approximately 500m from Cavendish Square which is a shopping mall with restaurants for meals (also available at the hall and around for less than \$10/meal).</i></p> <p>Reservations have to be made with the Organisers. Check in/out at the hotel is at 12h00. Accommodation charges must be paid by bank transfer. The host will issue an invoice upon request.</p> <p>Please make sure you send the Accommodation and Airport Transfer form at least 7 days before your arrival date.</p>
<p>Transportation</p>	<p>Transportation to and from the venue will be provided free of charge to participants and Officials for the official hotel only. Neighbourgood Newlands Hotel is about 17km from the airport (about 20m drive) and less than 10m drive from the hall.</p> <p>Please make sure you send the Accommodation and Airport Transfer form at least 7 days before your arrival date.</p>
<p>Temperature</p>	<p>In early December, the temperature varies between 27°C during the day and around 17°C at night.</p>
<p>Medical Services</p>	<p>The organisers will provide medical personnel at all times in the hall for the duration of the tournament.</p>
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property. BCA and the organisers will not be responsible for any medical cost.</p>
<p>Accreditation</p>	<p>Access to the Tournament venue and other services will be provided through personalised and photographic accreditation.</p>
<p>Clothing and Advertising</p>	<p>Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.</p>

<p>BWF ID</p>	<p>Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number. In case you wish to enter players, who don't have a BWF ID - number, you can now generate new BWF IDs for your players via Tournament Software.</p> <p>If you need help to generate new BWF IDs, please contact BWF or BCA (for African Countries) well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can be assigned BWF ID numbers before the closing date of the tournament.</p>
<p>Doping Control</p>	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. <p>Badminton Integrity</p>	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).</p> <p>For more information, please visit the website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/</p>
<p>Conditions</p>	<p>The tournament will be played on knock-out system and in full accordance with the General Competition Regulations of the BWF and the instructions of Badminton Confederation Africa.</p> <p>Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered. All prizes will be distributed during the official prize giving ceremony after the finals.</p> <p>Players shall not plan their departure before the prize giving ceremony; the organisers will not award medals or prize money until <u>ALL</u> finals are over.</p>

	<p>According to the BWF General Competition Regulations, there is no world ranking points for an international tournament with less than 8 entries in (MS, WS, MD, WD, XD).
