The medical forms for players with Sport Class Status N, R, or FRD must be submitted together with the entries and should be emailed to classification@bwf.sport by the submission deadline. A non-refundable fee of <b>USD 50</b> applies for new players who will undergo classification. Payment must be received by the BWF six (6) weeks before the classification date.
