Team Managers Meeting and Draw	The Team Managers Meeting will be held on Thursday 31st July 2025 @ 17:00hrs in the meeting room of venue. BCA Participation Grant	Each participating team (satisfying the conditions for team constitution, participation to the training camp and to the AirBadminton events) will be eligible to receive financial assistance which will include hotel and/or travel grant. The exact amount will be communicated to you after the entry deadline.	









Team Composition

Member Associations can enter a Mixed Team composed of at least 2 boys and 2 girls; that is, a minimum four (4) players and a maximum of 12 players (6 boys and 6 girls). If your team has less than 2 boys and 2 girls, you will NOT be allowed to play the Team Event Competitions and receive the BCA grant.

However, if any team has less than 2 boys and 2 girls, the Referee <u>may</u> allow them to play in the group stage only, <u>on a participatory basis</u>; that is their matches won't count for the group standing results and they won't qualify for the knock-out round or receive medals.

Regulation (Team Event)

The format of the Team Event Competition will be a group phase followed by a knock-out round. BWF General Competition Regulations (Section 5.2) will apply to the Championships and the relay points system as per section 5.2.1.

Each tie will be composed of five matches: one boys' singles, one girls' singles, one boys' doubles, one girls' doubles and one mixed doubles. Teams winning three or more matches in any tie will be declared as the tie winner. A player is not allowed to play in more than 2 matches per tie. In group stage, all five matches will be played.

The order of play for each match will be decided by the Referee and his/her decision will be final.

Depending on the number of players entered in a team, BCA will give a maximum of 12 medals per winning team (6 boys and 6 girls players) including, gold, silver and bronze medallists.

Seeding

The seeding of the Team event competition will be based on the results of the last edition in Harare, Zimbabwe and other preceding editions. The seeding of the Individual event competitions will be based on the results of the Team Event or as may be decided by the Referee. In any case, the Referee's decision will be final.









Age Limit	Only players born in 2011 and after (14 years old or less) will be eligible to participate in the tournament.
	Team Managers will be requested to submit passports of their players to the Referee/BCA team before the start of the Championships. In case of no passports, please bring a birth certificate accompanied by Student ID (including photo and biodata) or any other verifiable identification document. NO Student Card will be accepted without a birth certificate.
	The Referee may, at his/her discretion, order a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scan for any player (boy or girl) entered in the Championships.

Training Camp	BCA, in close collaboration with Badminton Association of Ghana, will organise a training camp for the Under 15 players prior to the start of the Championships (see schedule above). The camp will include both theory and practical sessions and will be led by BCA experts.
Visa	For all African Countries: All holders of African passports can enter Ghana without a visa.
Transportation	Transportation to and from the venue will be provided free of charge to Participants and Officials for the official hotels only. Both hotels are less than 30 minutes' drive from the airport and the Badminton venue is less than 30 minutes' drive from the hotels. Vaccination Restriction	Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is mandatory for entry to Ghana.
Clothing and Advertising	Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Doping Control	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).
