The Team Managers Meeting will be held on Sunday 8 th February 2026 @ 17:00hrs in the meeting room of the venue. The DRAW of the Team Event Competition will be held during the Team Managers Meeting. The seeding will be based on the BWF World Team Ranking and according to	
the BWF General Competition Regulations. The Referee's decision will be final. Each participating team (only) will be eligible to receive financial assistance which will include travel and/or a hotel grant. The exact amount will be communicated to you after the entry deadline.	









Member Associations can enter a maximum of one Men's Team or one Women's Team or both.

Each Team must be composed of MINIMUM four (4) players. If your team has less than four players, you will NOT be allowed to play the Team Event. BCA will give a maximum of 6 medals per winning team including, gold, silver and bronze medallists.

Team Composition & Regulations for Team Event

Each tie will be composed of five matches: 3 singles and two-level doubles. Teams winning three or more matches in any tie will be the winner. A player is not allowed to play more than 2 matches (one single and one double) per tie.

The order of play for each match will be decided by the Referee whose decision shall be final.

The format of the Team Event Competitions will be a group phase followed by a knock-out round.

All Entries must be submitted using the BWF Online Entry System.

Temperature	In February, the temperature varies around 31°C during the day and at night it's around 19°C.	









Medical Services	The organisers will provide medical personnel at all times in the hall for the duration of the tournament.
Insurance	Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property, including Covid-19 related costs. The organisers will not be responsible for any medical cost.
BWF ID	Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number. In case you wish to enter players, who don't have a BWF ID - number, you can now generate new BWF IDs for your players via Tournament Software.
	If you need help to generate new BWF IDs, please contact BWF or BCA (for African Countries) well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can be assigned BWF ID numbers before the closing date of the tournament.
Doping Control	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medications, they could check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Clothing and Advertising	Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.
	To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

The individual tournament will be played on knock-out system and in full accordance with the General Competition Regulations of the BWF and the instructions of Badminton Confederation Africa.

Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered. All prizes will be distributed during the official prize giving ceremony after the finals (or during, depending on the host).

Players shall not plan their departure before the prize giving ceremony; the organisers will not award medals before <u>ALL</u> finals are over.

Conditions

According to the BWF General Competition Regulations, there is no world ranking points for an international tournament with less than 8 entries in (MS, WS, MD, WD, XD). In such a case, the event may be cancelled, and the organisers will not take any responsibility for any arrangements that may have been already made.
